Read and Respond

Ephesians Chapter 2:1-10 and Chapter 2:11-22

- If we are dead because of sin, how are we made alive?
- What are some things that compel us to go the wrong direction spiritually?
- Discuss the relationship between grace and good works.
- Read Eph. 2:8-10; how do we attain salvation?
- What are some of the good works God created us to do?
- Christ is the head of the church; what part of the body of Christ are you?

Read and Respond

Eph. 3:1-13 and Eph. 3:14-21

- What was God's secret plan?
- How do you think the Jews and Gentiles felt about the plan?
- How can our suffering help others? How can it glorify Christ?
- What is Paul's first request of God in his opening prayer?
- What does it mean to be strengthened in your —inner being—?
- How are Paul's prayers similar or different from yours?

React by taking action

Show Christ your gratitude for what he has done for you this week by creatively expressing your thankfulness. This can be done through different ways: prayer, random act of kindness, helping someone in need...
